According to her, this would propagate all the cultural, moral and ethical values amongst the students.
- 4. Principal Madam wanted the faculty to continue with the synergic effort of involving the students in NSS and NCC activities. She expressed her happiness over extensive activities being taken up by NSS and NCC wings of the college. She said that celebration of Important Days, Physical activities, Campus- Community linkage, undertaking of Society Welfare Missions, Blood Donation Camps etc. would provide physical and mental grooming besides inculcating patriotic, moral and ethical and character-building values in students.
- 5. Madam Principal said that with ten faculty members holding a doctorate degree, there is a need to develop research inquisitiveness in students too that will lead them into exploring and learning. She encouraged the faculty to widen their knowledge horizon by engaging in research work besides regular teaching practices.
- Madam Principal laid emphasis on the fact that teachers must present their research
  papers at various Seminars/Conferences/Workshops at State/National level. This would
  promote the academic infrastructure of the institution.
- 7. Madam Principal said that mid-semester exams will be held during 2017-18 session which is essential for evaluation of progress of students and would identify the subject areas in which they need to improve. She instructed the members to arrange for remedial classes for weak and under privileged students.
- 8. Madam Principal explained the need of improvement of overall infrastructure of the students. She laid the importance on enhancement of Library, Common room, Office and departmental furnishing aspects. She said that in today's world with advanced technology, use of digital pursuits will be encouraged. Wi-Fi facilities will be intensified and new printers and scanners will be purchased.

- 9. Madam Principal stressed on the Career Counselling and Guidance activities. She instructed that concerned cell of the college should regularly arrange extension lectures and should stay in constant touch with "Employment Generation & Training Bureau, Kapurthala" to make the students aware of learning patterns viz-a-viz their interests, ambition & qualifications besides giving them glimpses of higher education offers as well as available job opportunities.
- 10. Madam Principal explained that faculty must take the students to "HOMES" of Special Children, Orphans, Old Age people, Leprosy-Ridden people etc. to see their plight, be empathetic towards them, learn to help them and be thankful to Almighty for having made them fortunate enough.
- 11. Madam Principal instructed the Council to help the institution to pace on a mantra of "Combined Academic-Sports" principle as physical activities will improve both mental & physical health, channelize surplus energy and alleviate depression, anxiety and stress.
- 12. Madam Principal talked about the provision for seminars in the college for dissemination of knowledge for students and faculty. Faculty members will be encouraged to attend Seminars/Conferences/ extension lectures which would be conducted by other institutions around the region.
- 13. Madam Principal said that Annual Sports meet and Annual Prize Distribution Function will be conducted by the college to encourage healthy competition and appreciate students' achievements in academic, sports & extracurricular activities carried out throughout the year.
- 14. Madam Principal explained that regular visit of teachers & students into college library will be taken care of. This will help in utilization of extensive knowledge treasure available in the library, besides imbibing of skills in various arenas by the visitors.
- 15. Madam Principal emphasized the importance of regular environment related activities like plantation drives, celebration of environment related days, picking up trash, sorting garbage etc. She said that exploring environment related issues will pave way to environment sustainability and students will learn the need to preserve natural resources to be available for the future generations.
- 16. All the IQAC members concertedly gave a nod to IQAC "Plan of Action" manifesto. The meeting ended with a vote of Thanks by Principal Madam Jatinder Kaur.
