Proceedings of the meeting were as follows:

 The names of the following two students were suggested and duly approved as Student members of IQAC for the year 2018-19.

- Principal Dr. V.K. Singh explained in detail the Plan of Action for the year 2018-19.
   He felt satisfaction with the successful conduct of inaugural session for new students in the college to acquaint the students about various activities in the college.
- For quality education and better discipline, Jubilee Hall of the college will be new common room for the girl students.
- 4. Principal Sir said that for up-to-date knowledge of the students, seminars, workshops and extension lectures will be arranged for students. Similarly, teachers will motivated to participate in seminars with their research papers.
- 5. Dr. V.K.
